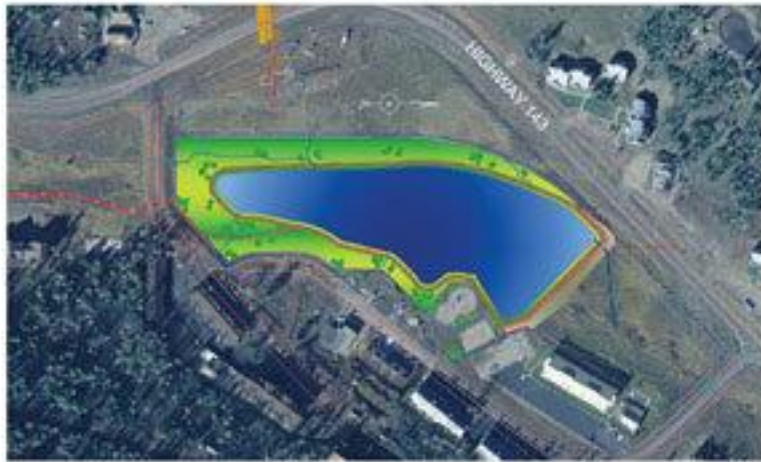

Brian Head opened its new lake/pond/reservoir during the summer of 2014 and is located just minutes from our condo. It is stocked with trout on a regular basis. It covers 4 acres and has a volume of 64.5 acre feet of water.

Walking or driving instructions:

1. Exit Copper Chase condo garage/driveway and go **LEFT** down the hill.
2. At HWY 143 make a **RIGHT**.
3. Go past the entrance to Giant Steps ski basin parking lot and then make your next **LEFT** on Vasels Rd.
4. Continue on Vasels Rd. bearing **RIGHT** and you will see the pond on your **RIGHT**.

Note: There is a covered picnic area and plenty of parking as well as a children's play area.

The fishing pond is surrounded by a beautiful walking path and numerous picnic areas with tables/benches and barbeques. There are also sand beaches and a boat launching ramp.

NO Fishing License Under 12 Years of Age Required: Under 12 years of age Utah Code § 23-19-21 and Utah Admin. Rule R657-13-3 If you're under 12 years of age, you do not need a fishing license to fish in Utah. You can fish without a license, use two poles and take a full daily limit. The only exception is if you'd like to fish with a setline. If you're under the age of 12 and would like to fish with a setline, you must purchase a Utah fishing or combination license and a setline permit. Please see page 12 for more information.

12 Years of Age and Older: Utah Code § 23-19-21 and Utah Admin. Rule R657-13-3 If you're 12 years of age or older, you must purchase a fishing license or a combination license to fish in Utah. You can choose from a variety of licenses: •Three-day fishing licenses allow you to fish for three consecutive days. •Seven-day fishing licenses allow you to fish for seven consecutive days. •365-day fishing licenses allow you to fish for 365 consecutive days, including the day you buy the license. •Multi-year fishing licenses allow you to fish for up to five years.

3. 1 ea. six compartment organizer (clear)
4. 6 ea. red/white round snap on floats (1 ¼")
5. 5 different size removable split shot weights (numerous quantiles of each)
6. 8 ea. Barrel swivels (size 10)
7. 6 ea. bait holder hooks (size 6)
8. 6 ea. 2x treble hooks (size 12)
9. Plastic hook disgorger
10. 1 pack power bait
11. 1 pack marshmallow trout bait
12. Stainless steel filet knife and sheath
13. 6" carbon steel pliers

****We have sized and selected the equipment above to be compatible with the size and type of fish (Brook Trout, Rainbow Trout & Tiger Trout, up to 14 inches) in the Brian Head pond.***



Note: We lock the tackle box and will provide a combination to an adult guest over the phone. This tackle box contains sharp hooks, knife and other equipment that should only be used under adult supervision. We have a 2nd (backup) tackle box should you need it.

Note: If you need help fishing, it is highly likely that there will be others fishing at the pond who will be more than happy to provide you with assistance. You can also go to Georg's Ski Shop located adjacent to the pond just across HWY 143 and tell them you are guests of the Kraft's. They provide fishing equipment sale & rental as well as fishing excursions to surrounding lakes and fishing spots. They also can arrange fly fishing adventures locally.

DISCLAIMER

We provide this equipment and the supplies at no charge to our guests for reasonable use. However, if the equipment is lost or damaged there will be a small charge to cover the replacement.

- The fishing poles/reel replacement cost is \$30.00 each.
- The tackle box and contents cost \$43.00.
- We expect hooks, sinkers, bait, line & swivels to be lost during normal fishing, so don't worry about such items.
